 - Resolution 1:** To resolve that the Neighbourhood Plan will be finalised with the revised BC 1, 2 and 3 Policies and other minor amendments, with the Sustainability Appraisal (EDDC), the Compliance Report and Communications Summary. The final drafts to be presented to the PC and then released for public consultation.
 - Resolution 2:** To adopt the Blackdown Hills AONB Design Guide and incorporate into the Neighbourhood Plan and give proper consideration to EDDC Heritage Strategy.
 - Resolution 3:** To set up a sub-group of the PC to advise and report back on the legal format, process and finance required to create a working Community Land Trust. The aim of any such CLT will be the provision of community resources, services or activities for the benefit of the community. In the first instance the task of the CLT will be specifically to acquire land, secure Planning permission, assess the need for and then if relevant build affordable housing for local people and retain ownership in perpetuity for the benefit of the community as defined exclusively by the boundary of the Parish.
 - Resolution 4:** To agree the members of the group.
 - Resolution 5:** To agree a 'call facility' to the maximum amount proposed subject to normal approval processes which will enable the group to access funds prior to the acquisition of grant monies.
