To qualify to become a Parish Councillor a person must:

- *be a British subject over 18 years old
- *be listed on the current electoral roll
- *live in Broadhembury parish, or occupy as owner/tenant any land/premises therein or have a principal place of work within the Parish
- *must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor.
